

# 2024 National Coaching Certification Program

## High Performance 1 Clinic

Moncton, NB

**May 21 – Virtual orientation & group session**

**May 24 to 26 – HP1 National Virtual Weekend**

**May or June (TBD) – Virtual multi-sport modules**

**May 31 – June 2 – In-person seminar in Moncton, NB**

The 2024 seminar will be delivered in three parts consisting of an on-line virtual portion, a recorded module portion, and an in-class portion. Participants are required to take part in all parts of the HP1 Program. Within one year, the HP1 Written assignment must be completed and passed. Coaches will have two (2) hockey seasons after attending the seminar to be fully certified.

## HP1 Background and Eligibility Criteria

The NCCP High Performance 1 Seminar is held every two to three years in Atlantic Canada and is targeted at those coaches who have significant coaching experience and want to pursue higher levels of coaching competitive athletes.

Those coaches applying for NCCP HP 1 Certification through this clinic must meet the following criteria:

- Must be currently coaching at the U13AAA competitive level or higher.
- Coaches must have a minimum of three years of coaching experience at the U13/U15 level or higher.
- Special situations will warrant consideration.

To complete the field evaluation following the seminar, coaches must be coaching at the U13AAA level or higher in the upcoming season.

***As part of the selection process a maximum of 40 candidates will be accepted. Beyond experience and current coaching situation, the selection process will also consider:***

- Previous NCCP coach education and/or certification
- A history of ethical coaching and the development of athletes
- Work within the Hockey Canada structure in other leadership roles - instructor, mentor, facilitator, etc.
