



New Brunswick Hockey Officials Association – 2020-2021 Certification

Due to COVID-19, New Brunswick Hockey Officials Association will be adjusting how official's recertification and new clinics are delivered during the 2020-2021 season.

Returning officials will now recertify for the season using an online module-based clinic and exam. Returning officials will need to sign up for an 'Official Recert Clinic' at their current level. There are no level upgrades this season. Follow the instructions that are with the clinic information. Officials who are Level 3-6 will need to complete the HU-Planning a Safe Return to Hockey free online clinic before they can recertify. The Recert clinics will be available to sign up and start on Monday September, 28th. Instructions on how to sign up for clinics will be available on the HNB website under official's tab, click on returning officials or from your local Referee in Chief. The HU-Planning a Safe Return to Hockey is available now and can be done anytime as a prerequisite for Levels 3-6 to recertify. As of right now, due to COVID restrictions we are holding off on hosting clinics for NEW officials, we plan to revisit these clinics in the new year.
